

Sarva Shiksha success to be studied at world meet

New Delhi: In a rare honour to government-run Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan, aimed at attaining universalisation of elementary education, the programme would be feted for the next two days in Manila, as a success story in a meeting of forum on aid effectiveness.

Manila meeting organised by the Department for International Development, World Bank and Asian Development Bank has selected SSA as a case study as it believes that the programme "is an excellent example of a government-led, highly effective development partnership in elementary education that is enabling millions of previously excluded children to go to school".

The Indian delegation will make a detailed presentation about SSA and how it is proposed to make the programme more effective among marginalised people. Innovations carried out by different states as well as its monitoring mechanism will be highlighted at the meeting.
